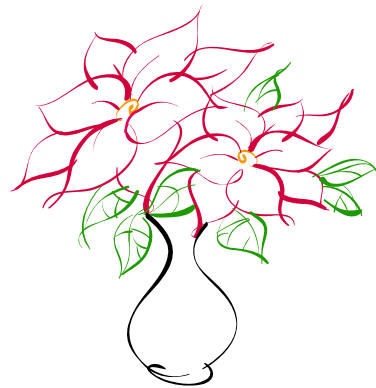

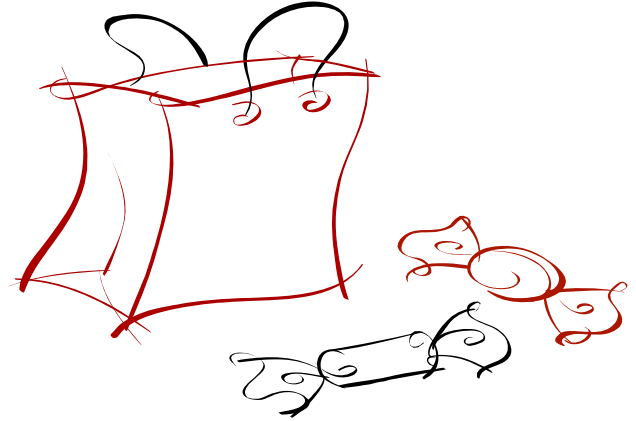

What Every Quilter Should Know

- ◆ **General meetings** are on the 4th Thursday of every month except November (3rd Thursday) and December (no meeting). Occasionally, there are exceptions to this rule, so check your newsletter carefully. Meetings take place in the Fellowship Hall of Christ the King Lutheran Church, 495 Florida Road in Durango. Social time starts at 5:30 p.m. and the meeting starts at 6:00 p.m.
- ◆ **Board meetings** take place on the first Thursday of each month at Christ the King Lutheran Church at 5:00 p.m. All members of LPQG are welcome to attend Board meetings, whether they wish to participate or just observe.
- ◆ **Hives** are casual gatherings of LPQG members, usually held in members' homes once per month. Hives are open to all LPQG members – just contact the hostess to let her know you're coming. Check page 7 of this Newsletter for details on all of the hives currently in existence.
- ◆ We have a **block of the month** each month. All LPQG members are encouraged to participate. Just pick up a pattern from the program table and make the block for the following month. Then turn in your block at the next meeting to contribute to the Public Outreach Project. There will be a sew day once a month to put the blocks together.
- ◆ The **Annual Small Quilt Benefit Auction** is held on the first Sunday of June each year. LPQG members are asked to donate a small quilt for the auction, with the proceeds being donated to local charitable groups.
- ◆ Our **Outreach** programs are our connection to the community. We make quilts to donate to various organizations each year. Announcements and information are always in the newsletter and at meetings.
- ◆ We make a **raffle quilt** each year. LPQG members make the raffle quilt and tickets go on sale in early April. The drawing is held at the La Plata County Fair.
- ◆ LPQG is the Superintendent of the quilt section of **La Plata County Fair**. In this capacity, we take in the quilts, hire judges, hang the quilt display, and protect the quilts during the time the Fair is open to the public.
- ◆ LPQG has a **quilt show** in the even numbered years during the fall. All LPQG members are encouraged to show their quilts.
- ◆ We wear **nametags** to get to know each other. If you forget to wear yours, you need to pay a quarter at the sign-in table. You can also pick up a sticky nametag there.
- ◆ The **Hospitality Committee** organizes our snacks for each meeting, plus setting up all the tables and chairs we need. Signup sheets are passed around regularly, so please be sure to lend a hand.
- ◆ The **Board of Directors** is here to answer your questions. Please feel free to contact anyone on the Board.

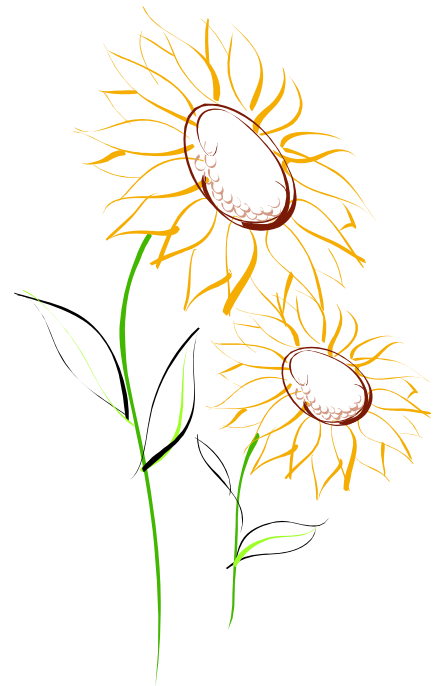

2010 RAFFLE QUILT

Our raffle quilt, Twisting Leaves, is now complete thanks for all of the excellent participation from our guild members.

In December, Beth Emrich, had an outreach day at Christ the King Lutheran Church. It was a wonderful opportunity for us to get the raffle quilt pinned and ready for quilting.

We were able to set up several of the church tables to accommodate the quilt top which measures 100" x 100"! This should be a nice bed sized quilt for most everyone. Special thanks to Karen Benson, Cindy Amidon, Anne St. John and Britt for pinning the quilt. Cindy Amidon was also generous in providing the cotton quilt batting for our quilt as well as a number of beautiful variegated threads used on the leaves and borders of the raffle quilt.

Karen Benson then brought the quilt home and did all of the "in the ditch" quilting. The free motion quilting on the leaves, veins of the leaves, and borders was done by Britt. Variegated threads were used to create leaves and butterflies on the outside borders.

The next step was to attach the binding to the quilt by machine. This was done by Britt.

Finishing of the hanging sleeve and hand stitching of the binding was done by Britt, Heather Lundquist and Diane Mattern.

A beautiful quilt label was created by Terri Taylor on her embroidery machine, and makes a beautiful finishing touch on back of the quilt! Check it out!

The total expenses to create this exquisite quilt was \$118.45! Because of all of your generous donations of fabric, batting, threads and quilting, our guild should be able to earn a very sizeable profit for our future guild endeavors.

Thank you all for your generous donations and help to accomplish our "Twisting Leaves" 2010 raffle quilt. The quilt will be first displayed at the 4-Corners Luncheon on Saturday, March 27 where everyone will have an opportunity to purchase their winning raffle quilt ticket! We will also display the quilt at various locations during the year and raffle quilt tickets should be available at our monthly guild meetings beginning in March. BLOCK OF THE MONTH

Janessa Ezzell

This Block of the Month is offered in two different styles. There are 12 months in this project.

One set of instructions is available for redwork, the other for appliqué. The appliqué designs are printed with the expectation of hand appliqué. If you want to use fusible appliqué (such as Heat-n-Bond) you will need to reverse the patterns. Flipping over the pattern onto a light box and tracing it is the easiest way.

The instructions for each month will be given during that month's meeting, with two exceptions; January and February will be given at the February meeting along with general instructions and November and December will be given at the November meeting. Finishing instruction will be available at the November meeting as well. If you have signed up but miss a meeting, Janessa will save your instructions for you.

If you decide at any point throughout the year that you would like to start participating, let Janessa know and she will catch you up. If you decide that you don't want any more blocks, let Janessa know.

**Small Quilt Auction**

It's that time again! We're planning our 11th Annual Small Quilt Benefit Auction – can you believe it? For those of you new to the guild, the most important information about the SQA is listed below:

What is it? SQA is our largest fund-raiser, and our largest Community Outreach event. Most of the money raised at our SQA is given away to local charitable organizations focusing on women, children and families. This year, Blue Star Mothers of Durango, Manna Soup Kitchen, Project Linus, Volunteers of America Southwest Safehouse, and Womenade of La Plata County will each receive 15% of the proceeds. Whatever funds are left after we make our donations to the chosen charitable organizations and cover the expenses of the auction will stay in the guild to fund our other outreach and educational programs.

When is it? We hold the SQA on the first Sunday of June. This year, the date is June 6, 2010. We set up our racks in the morning, at noon we have the preview, and at 1:00 p.m., the auction begins!

Where is it? LPQG has reserved Rotary Park again this year for our auction, and again we will have big tents over the chairs for shade during the auction.

What do we auction? We auction small (and not so small) quilts - wall hangings, pillows, place mats - or anything else donated to the cause.

How can I help? We rely on our generous LPQG members to supply whatever they can to raise funds for our charitable organizations, so whatever you have time to make and donate will be appreciated. 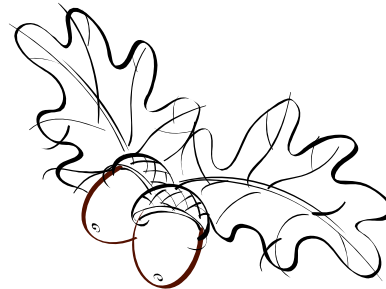
